Patient Centered Medicine/Physical Diagnosis skills (second year) – office or hospital. Students will go to the office or hospital one or more half-days per month to learn basic H&P skills. Sometimes they will need up to 2 hours of observations during a session, but most days the direct time commitment is substantially less. There is also a need for subspecialists in cardiology, rheumatology, pulmonary, and GI to have students in their offices as part of focused physical exam training.

**Patient Centered Medicine (first year)** – shadowing in office. Meet with students to focus early on patient interaction skills. Time commitment is several half-days.
